The intention

42 is a work based on the study of geometry, particularly the circle, both as a tool for musical composition and in the architectural design of sound diffusion.

The title "42" references the main antagonist from the animated film Akira by director Katsuhiro Ōtomo. Ctrl-Z extends the narrative of this film to explore new artistic challenges.

The work is composed for spatialized diffusion and is divided into seven phases, like chapters, each with its own unique sound universe. Sometimes abstract, sometimes minimalist, the choice of instruments creates sharp contrasts between each movement. Indonesian gamelans with their intricate clockwork meet organs, choirs, and Western instruments. Phases of electronic music propel the cities depicted, reshaping their material to create new soundscapes. The sea and rain blend with cycles of repetitive arpeggios, soothing listeners like a gentle summer night.

For the lighting design, lasers are used as the main element, creating dense, futuristic, and minimalist images. Their absence plunges the audience into darkness, refocusing their attention on auditory perception.

Beyond the concept, geometry becomes space, offering an experience crystallized by individual perception—intimate and bordering on the sacred.



Collaborators



As a teenager, he discovered the creative possibilities offered by digital technology. Immersed in a period of technological and musical innovation, he absorbed emerging musical trends.

He became involved in various projects as a musician, composer, and technician. With his latest musical entity, Ctrl-Z, he focuses on electronic music and digital visual arts. His work reflects on the human-machine dialogue and the relationship between technology and spirituality. It is during live performances, with specially designed scenography, that his cyber-universe takes full shape.

With the "42" project, his drive for experimentation led him to explore new musical horizons and compositional methods, resulting in a performance that combines sound immersion and laser projection. He frequently shares his

discoveries with enthusiasm through workshops and conferences for all audiences.

In 2024, following the "42" project, Ctrl-Z returns to his control tower for a new immersive and performative project, featuring progressive techno with massive bass and a rich sonic universe. Lasers precisely shape and redefine surfaces and spaces. The goal is to immerse spectators in a 360-degree environment, structured live.

You enter a circle of sound immersion, where world music meets electronic music and geometry. Where lasers outline the contours of new visual spaces.


Sound Immersion Experience


The sound architecture was designed with a circle of 12 speakers placed around the audience, reminiscent of a clock face. Using technology developed by Flux::Audio, the work adapts to technical constraints and venue dimensions while maintaining its staging and scale.

The audience is invited into this immersive universe to explore dynamic, mobile spaces where sound objects orbit around them. These sound objects are animated by interfaces and programs based on geometric principles, creating a synthesis between technology and composition.

A specially designed control structure integrates instruments and control tools, enabling real-time mixing and spatialization. This control tower makes the installation self-sufficient through network protocols for communication.
